To All Residents of Sloatsburg:

The Village of Sloatsburg has limited funds available through its Senior Citizen Health and Safety Program to provide health and safety devices to senior citizens with incomes that fall within acceptable HUD income levels. Examples of these items are grab bars, railings, smoke alarms, door or window locks, walkers not covered by Medicare or medical insurance, etc.

The funds for this program have been provided by the County of Rockland Office of Community Development, through the office of the County Executive.

To be considered for this program, you must be 60 years of age or older, rent or own your primary residence in Sloatsburg and have a total resident (household) income equal to or below HUD low / moderate income guidelines.

The following are the HUD guidelines for income eligibility:

1 Person	\$45,100.00
Family of 2	\$51,550.00
Family of 3	\$58,000.00
Family of 4	\$64,400.00
Family of 5	\$69,600.00
Family of 6	\$74,750.00
Family of 7	\$79,900.00
Family of 8	\$85,050.00

If you believe you meet these requirements and are in need of health or safety devices, please don't hesitate to contact the Sloatsburg Village office in person or call 845-753-2727 to receive a Community Development Committee Application for Financial Assistance. All application information will remain confidential and will be reviewed and judged on a case-by-case basis.

If you are not a senior citizen but in need of financial assistance and meet the HUD income guidelines shown above, please contact the Village Office to see if you are eligible for assistance through our other programs.
