The foregoing was seconded by Trustee Akey and was duly adopted by unanimous vote.

Resolution # 14-049 Replacement Receipt for Service Revolver

Trustee Akey offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

That the Village Board authorizes the Village Clerk to issue a replacement receipt to John Bonkoski for his purchase of a surplus service revolver from the Village of Sloatsburg, Serial Number AAP2461, on or about December 1993, based upon an affidavit of John Bonkoski, sworn to on the 22nd day of April, 2014.

The foregoing was seconded by Trustee O'Leary and duly adopted; Trustee Bonkoski abstained.

Update on Road Signs

Trustee Akey commented that they have received good reviews on the new signs. They would also like to put new street signs along other major arteries throughout the Village, such as Seven Lakes Drive and Eagle Valley Road. The cost

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would be approximately \$9,800. Trustee O'Leary agreed that it would be the natural progression.

On a motion by Trustee O'Leary, seconded by Trustee Buckley to move forward with additional signs for the Village. All in favor, motion carried.
